

Notes of the MLGG Meeting 22nd September 2010

Fuel Duty

Myra informed all present that Jersey Harbours had agreed a deal to give with the Treasury Minister Philip Ozouf £200,000 for not implementing Fuel Duty during 2011. This was agreed in principal last Friday. This does not prevent any States Member raising the issue in the House. It is intended to increase the 2011 mooring charges by 5%. This is to be discussed with St.H.B.O.A on the 30th of September.

La Collette

The replacement of La Collette pontoons should take place between January and March 2011 at a cost of £700000. Business plan has been produced. The facilities block will also be updated with in this costing.

St. Aubin's structural repairs

The cost of work to St. Aubin's Fort and the North Quay at St. Aubin's will cost 1.6 million. Harbours have just been informed at the eleventh hour that it will not be States funded.

Gorey Harbour

The repairs to Gorey Pier, which are due to be carried out during 2013, will cost 3 million. Again Harbours will have to fund the work along with any repairs to any quay or harbour in the island.

St. Helier marina

The electricity points are to be replaced during 2011 at a cost of a £100000.

Winter Contracts

Contracts will only be issued from October until the end of January. Boats from La Collette and St. Aubin's will need to occupy berths in the town marina after that date.

Boat Show

The date was confirmed for the 2011 Boat Show 30th April until the 2nd May.

Old Harbour

Ray Hine stated that the drying Harbour moorings would be looked at to make some improvements. He asked for MS to work with him on a sub group to plan a way forward. The work would need to be done in stages due to finance restrictions.

Additional moorings

Ray Hine presented harbours provisional plans for additional moorings. In general the plans were well received with no negative comments.
