

Highways Maintenance

Essential maintenance works are required to repair and preserve one of Jersey's most significant routes for commercial and domestic traffic.

Commencing: Tuesday 28 June 2011

Anticipated Completion: Mid September 2011

Extent of Works: From the junction with Route de la Liberation to the junction with Mount Bingham

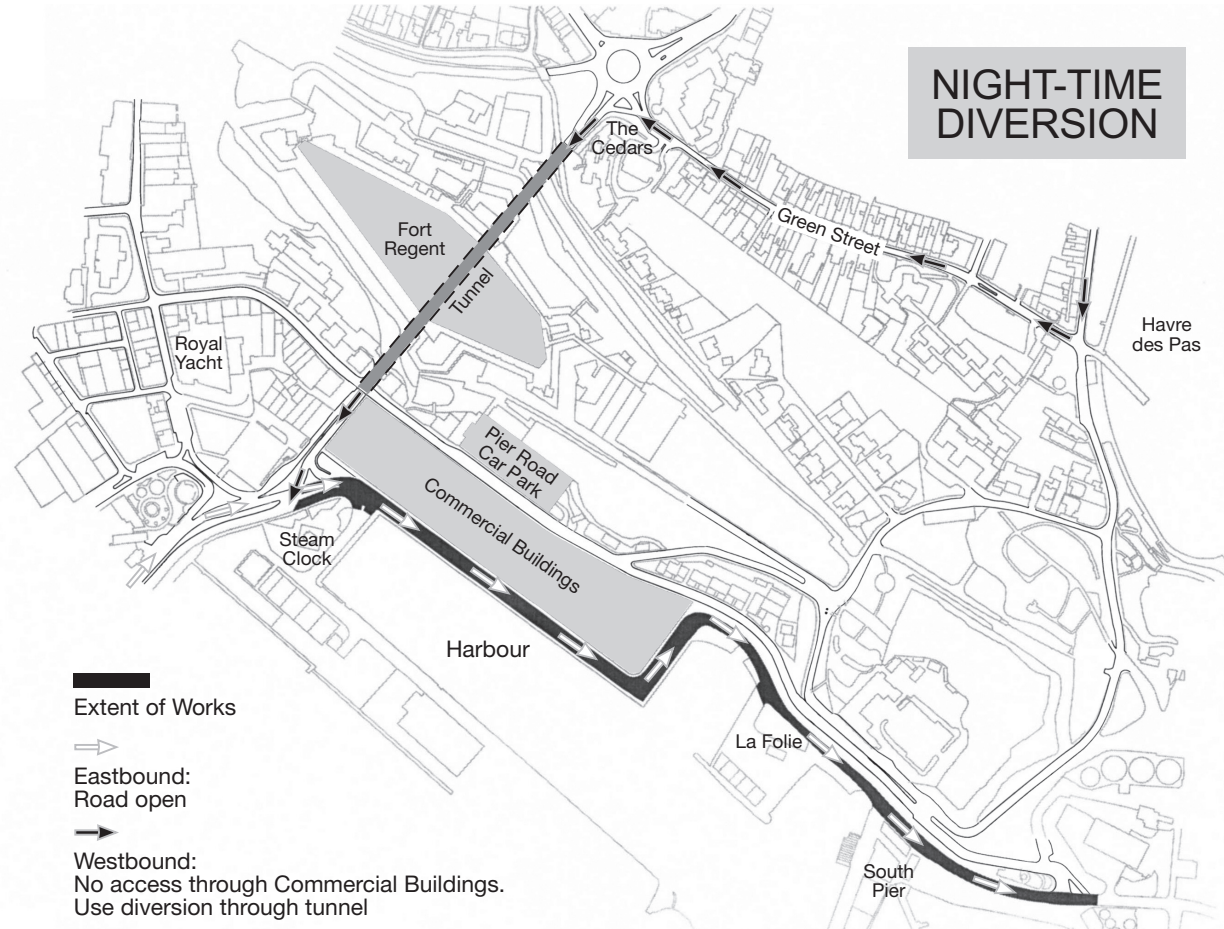
Traffic restrictions

Daytime and evenings (Monday to Saturday)

Before 7.30pm: Road open to two way traffic.
Lane closures

Night-time (Monday to Friday)

7.30pm to 2.00am: Road open to eastbound traffic only. Westbound traffic to use the tunnel.

Other traffic management:

- Road closures will be required for certain areas of the works. These will be advertised, in advance, in local media.
- Please respect the mandatory and enforceable speed limits during lane closures for the protection of other road-users and workers.
- Please take extra care during night-works: Road layouts will be amended and there may not be streetlights. Also, please be vigilant for pedestrians and vehicles exiting residences.
- Car parking will be suspended in sections adjacent to resurfacing works and on diversion routes during road closures.

Access:

- Access to premises will be from the west, except during road closures, for which access arrangements will be advertised in advance in local media.
- The Contractor will notify local media and all residents and businesses along Commercial Buildings of access arrangements during road closures.
- Any road-users requiring specific advice relating to access can contact the Traffic Coordinator on 856566.
- All businesses within and adjacent to the works will be open as usual.

Buses:

- Bus times should not be affected by the works.

Transport and Technical Services and their contractor, Geomarine, apologise in advance for any disruption caused by these essential Highways Maintenance Works.
